

4R Voucher Program Enrollment

Winter 2026–2027 · Winter Small Grains · Complete one form per farm

Each agribusiness advisor should fill out this enrollment form to reserve a \$1,000 planning voucher for each farmer client. Five vouchers can be used, per agribusiness, until September 18, 2026. Vouchers must be reserved by submitting this form to Jenell McHenry (midatlantic4r@gmail.com). These vouchers are not guaranteed. Additional vouchers still available on September 18, 2026 will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until all are spoken for.

Historically underserved vouchers are also available at \$1,250 each.

The reporting section of this form, and associated documentation, is due by March 1, 2027.

If you plan to implement the planned practice and receive cost-share, the completed report must be submitted 30 days prior to implementation to be approved. Implementation is available to the farmer for specified practices only.

Technical assistance funding is available to the agribusiness for implementation and reporting.

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A W-9 for the agribusiness is attached. Please note that the voucher funding goes to the agribusiness, not the farmer.

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The farmer and advisor are willing to participate in an interview with MA4R about their Voucher Program experience in the summer of 2027.

1. Complete this entire form to enroll one farm.
2. Email this form to Jenell McHenry, along with proof of a nutrient management plan and your agribusiness W-9.
3. Wait for Jenell to confirm the application has been received and funding is available.
4. Complete the voucher before March 1. Jenell will send you a reporting form as soon as they are available.
5. On March 1, or earlier, email Jenell a completed reporting form with field maps and proof of your planned activity.
6. Once all data has been received — or no later than August 1 — payment to your agribusiness will be processed.
7. Jenell must approve the planned activity or practice for cost-share to be promised.
